July 21, 2022

Weinandt and Fiedler reported on CKRWP activities. Weinandt presented recommendations from the July 14, 2022; meeting of the Cedar Knox Rural Water Project Advisory Committee as follows:

Chair Heine provided the public time to make comments. Comments and questions were received pertaining to conversion of CKRWP's water source from the at-risk surface water intake to a groundwater source. The board and staff addressed the questions asked.
