# LEWIS & CLARK NRD MINUTES

May 23, 2024

Chair Weinandt called the May 23, 2024, meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District (LCNRD) Board of Directors to order at 7:02 p.m. in the conference room at the LCNRD office.
