June 20, 2024

Chair Weinandt called the June 20, 2024, meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District (LCNRD) Board of Directors to order at 7:02 p.m. in the conference room at the LCNRD office. Chair Weinandt stated that prior notice of the meeting had been publicized according to policy designated by the board and that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall of the meeting room. Roll call of members. Present: Condon, Heine, Johnson, Kollars, Kramer, Lamb, and Weinandt. Absent: Armstrong, Christensen, Schmidt, and Steffen.

CONSENT AGENDA

Consent agenda reviewed. It was moved by Kramer, seconded by Kollars to approve minutes of the May 23, 2024, board meeting and the May 24 to June 20, 2024, consent agenda. <u>Resources District in the County of Cedar, Knox, and Dixon with 75% of the board present voting aye, the district approved the additional 1% increase allowable on base restrictions for the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget of the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District in accordance with Nebraska Revised Statute 13-519 at the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District Board Meeting held on June 20, 2024.</u>

- 1. <u>To approve entering an agreement with Lower Elkhorn NRD for a Source Water Protection position, to work on conservation practices to mitigate nitrates for a cost of \$368,470 with LCNRD portion being \$55,000 over a 3-year period and the remaining covered by LENRD and NRCS.</u>
- 2. <u>To approve the purchase of a tractor, tree planter, tiller and all related equipment for tree planting needs by LCNRD staff in 2025.</u>
