LEWIS & CLARK NRD MINUTES

August 15, 2024

Chair Weinandt called the August 15, 2024, meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District (LCNRD) Board of Directors to order at 7:01 p.m. in the conference room at the LCNRD office. Chair Weinandt stated that prior notice of the meeting had been publicized according to policy designated by the board and that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall of the meeting room. Roll call of members. Present: Christensen, Heine, Johnson, Kollars, Kramer, Lamb, Schmidt, Steffen, and Weinandt. Absent: Armstrong and Condon.

CONSENT AGENDA

Consent agenda reviewed. It was moved by Kramer, seconded by Johnson to approve minutes of the July 18, 2024, board meeting and the July 19 to August 15, 2024, consent agenda. BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT & RECOMMENDATIONS

Heine reported on and presented recommendations from the budget committee.

It was moved by Steffen, seconded by Kramer to approve the FY2025 draft budget, planned projects attached to the file copy of the minutes and the following recommendations:

- 1. <u>Approve management entering into a 5-year agreement with the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources for reimbursement of half the LCNRD annual cost for the Bow Creek streamgage located in the Wynot area with a total of up to \$25,300.</u>
- 2. <u>Approve management to enter the Bow Creek Watershed 319 funded project for 3 year grant contract with Nebraska Department of Environment & Energy with \$300,000 grant and \$200,000 match requirement.</u>
- 3. Support the Sandhills Interactive Natural Resources Education Complex with \$1,000 payment.
