LEWIS & CLARK NRD MINUTES

October 17, 2024

Chair Weinandt called the October 17, 2024, meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District (LCNRD) Board of Directors to order at 3:03 p.m. in the conference room at the LCNRD office. Chair Weinandt stated that prior notice of the meeting had been publicized according to policy designated by the board and that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall of the meeting room. Roll call of members. Present: Armstrong, Christensen, Condon, Heine, Johnson, Kollars, Schmidt, Steffen, and Weinandt. Absent: Kramer and Lamb.

CONSENT AGENDA

Consent agenda reviewed. It was moved by Armstrong, seconded by Heine to approve minutes of September 19, 2024, board meeting and the September 20 to October 17, 2024, consent agenda. The consent agenda includes financial reports, cost share approvals, claims, corrections, and additions (attached to file copy of minutes). Chair Weinandt opened the floor to public comment. No public in attendance.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES

Manager's Report: Sudbeck reported on recent LCNRD and CKRWP activities and reviewed several agreements before the board for approval. *It was moved by Kollars, seconded by Schmidt to approve the following contract amendments and agreements stated below, and allow management to enter into such agreements:*

- 1. Approve 3-year NARD Interlocal Agreement for obtaining seedling trees and shrubs.
- 2. Approve 3-year NDEE agreement 56-2381 for the Bow Creek Watershed Phase II Activities.
- 3. Approve 2-year lobbyist agreement with Peetz & Co. for \$36,000 per year.
- 4. <u>Approve amendment #7 to the Cooperative Agreement with UNL-CSD for \$60,000 to complete the replacement observation wells at Powder Creek developed in the Dakota Formation.</u>
- 5. <u>Approve extension of the UNL Bazile Extension Educator agreement to utilize funding from the last</u> agreement while a new agreement is being considered for the next 5-year period.
- 6. <u>Approve 3-year NDEE 319 agreement for Bazile Creek Watershed Phase III activities carried by LENRD with LCNRD providing 20% (\$40,000) of the match requirement over the 3-year period.</u>

- 3. <u>Gayle Becker well permit LC-504R for a well in the NWNW Section 28 T30N R3W and flow meter cost share FMLC-504R.</u>
- 4. <u>Eric, Adam, & Mark Heimes well permits LC-505 and LC506 for wells in the SESW & SWSE Section 5 T32N R2E, expanded acre permit X-24034 for 184 irrigated in the S1/2S1/2 section 5 & N1/2NE Section 8 T30N R2E, and flow meter cost share FMLC-505.</u>
