

LEWIS & CLARK NRD MINUTES

December 18, 2025

Chair Schmidt called December 18, 2025, meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District (LCNRD) Board of Directors to order at 1:32 p.m. in the conference room at the LCNRD office.
