LEWIS & CLARK NRD MINUTES

May 16, 2019

Chairman Steffen called the May 16, 2019 meeting of the Lewis & Clark Natural Resources District Board of Directors to order at 7:05 pm at the Lewis & Clark NRD Office, Hartington NE. Chairman Steffen stated prior notice of the meeting had been publicized according to policy designated by the board and announced to the public present that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is located on the west wall of the meeting room.

CONSENT AGENDA

The consent agenda and financial reports were reviewed. <u>It was moved by Kramer, seconded by Heine to</u> <u>approve the minutes of the April 17, 2019 board meeting and the April 18 to May 16, 2019 consent agenda</u> <u>which includes the financial reports, cost share approvals, claims, cancellations, and corrections. (Copy</u> <u>attached to file copy of minutes)</u>. Roll call vote: AYE: Christensen, Heine, Howey, Kramer, Schmidt, Steffen. <u>NAY: None. ABSENT: Armstrong, Condon, Hoesing, Johnson, Weinandt. BAZILE REPORT

Phil Steinkamp, Bazile Groundwater Management Area Coordinator, reported on recent Bazile meetings and activities. Steinkamp sent letters to approximately 300 cooperators on sealing wells and received 80 responses (none for decommissioning within the LCNRD). Steinkamp is working on 319 funding for BGMA Tier 1 & 2 producers. Dr. Dan Snow, UNL, plans to do vadose testing in the Bazile area. Demonstration sites for irrigation management, irrigation technology, and nitrogen management are being evaluated and established with funding from a Nebraska Environmental Trust Grant.

DIRECTORS ACTIVITY

RC&D & Wau Col: Howey reported the Northeast Nebraska RC&D office, as of May, will be located in Ponca. Meetings will be rotated to each board member's community with the next meeting May 28th at Howey's office. RC&D received a \$12,900 grant for NDEQ Hazardous Waste Collection with Hartington and Wayne as possible collection points. Plainview Farmers Market and Ponca Farmers Market are some RC&D projects this year. No Wau Col Rural Water System report as there was no meeting this month.

Natural Resources Commission: Steffen reported the Natural Resources Commission (NRC) received full funding appropriation of \$11 million for fiscal year 2020 for the Water Sustainability Fund. Greg Wilke, Middle Niobrara NRD director, is chair of the program NRC committee and serving on the executive committee.

Kramer provided an update on the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts. The next meeting will be June 10th prior to NARD Basin Tour.

Missouri Sedimentation Action Coalition Meetings (MSAC): Heine reported she and Sudbeck attended MSAC meetings April 23rd. MSAC is looking for stakeholders to give input on the sediment in the Lewis & Clark Lake. MSAC is applying for state implemented Section 22 funding from United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). Paul Boyd, USACE, is writing the application for sediment control on the Lewis & Clark lake.

CEDAR KNOX RURAL WATER PROJECT REPORT

Scott Fiedler reported on the Cedar Knox Rural Water Project Advisory Committee meeting held Tuesday, April 9th and the following recommendations were made for the Lewis & Clark NRD board to act on.

- 1. <u>Approve the minutes of the April 9th, 2019 rural water meeting</u>
- 2. Approve the expenses from April 12th, 2019 May 9th, 2019 as presented.

Fiedler reported on items reviewed at the rural water meeting. (Report attached to file copy of minutes). <u>It was</u> moved by Kramer, seconded by Howey to approve the rural water report and each of the recommendations as

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITES

Manager Sudbeck reported on spring well monitoring results. (Weinandt enters the meeting and Howey leaves the meeting at 8:55 pm.)

Lammers, Water Res Tech, reported there are no new well permits or acre expansion requests. There are 4 modifications to legal descriptions of permits inaccurately presented at previous meetings. <u>It was moved by</u> <u>Schmidt, seconded by Steffen to approve:</u>

Modification to correct the legal described location of well LC-216 & LC-217 to the SENE section 36-32N-2E and the irrigated acre expansion X-18014 to SENE & NESE section 36-32N-2E.
Modification to correct the legal described location of well LC-220 to the SENE section 36-32N-2E.
Modification to correct the legal described location of well LC-234 to the NWSW section 32-29N-1W.

Manager Sudbeck reported tree planting is complete and went smoothly. Approximately 9500 trees were planted; hand plant sales were around 4500. The upcoming Water Quality Management Plan meeting will be held May 28th at the Wynot Fire Hall with open house starting at 5:30 pm and supper provided at 6:00 pm with speakers from the Shell Creek Watershed, NRCS, NG&P, NDEQ, and FYRA Engineering. Middle Niobrara NRD is proposing an education center for water resources at their property in Valentine. LCNRD and other NRDs, NDEQ, UNL Extension, and other agencies are working with MNNRD on the proposal.

Lammers, Baldwin, Bermel, and Schumacher reported on their activities this month.

NRCS REPORT

Tyler Specht, NRCS, was unable to attend the meeting, Manager Sudbeck presented his report, which is attached to the file copy of the minutes.
