

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Relating to the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District Rules and Regulations for Conduct of Evidentiary Hearings, for Conduct of Informational Public Hearings and for Rules and Regulations for Enforcement

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §2-3228, the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District (District) hereby provides notice that the District shall hold a public hearing at its regular board meeting on December 1, 2020 at 12:45 PM, at the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District Office, 608 North Robinson Avenue, Hartington, Nebraska. The purpose of the hearing is to receive testimony on the proposed, restated District Rules and Regulations for Conduct of Evidentiary Hearings, for Conduct of Informational Public Hearings, and for Rules and Regulations for Enforcement.

A general description of the content of the Rule for Conduct of Informational Public Hearings is 1) Calling Public Hearings, 2) Notice, 3) Presiding Officer or Hearing Examiner, 4) Powers of Officer or Examiner, 5) Oath Not Required, 6) Receipt of Information, 7) Presentation of Information, 8) Propriety of Information, 9) Staff Information, 10) Record Made, and 11) Record Held Open.

A general description of the content of the Rules and Regulations for Enforcement is 1) General Provisions and Procedures for Enforcement, 2) Inspections, 3) Submission of Inspection Report Alleging Violation and Alleged Violator's Alternative, 4) Schedule of Compliance, 5) Voluntary Compliance, 6) Evidentiary Hearing, and 7) Board Authorization to Initiate Court Action.

The full text of the proposed, restated rules is available at the District office located at 608 North Robinson Avenue, Hartington, Nebraska as well as on the District's website lcnrd.nebraska.gov.

Any interested person may appear at the hearing and present written or oral testimony concerning this matter. Individuals with disabilities may request auxiliary aids and service necessary for participation by contacting the District by December 01, 2020. Testimony relevant to the purposes of the hearing may also be submitted in writing prior to the close of the hearing to the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District, PO Box 518, 608 North Robinson Avenue, Hartington, NE 68739.
