- 1. Engineering Application form completed, signed, and dated.
- 2. 1 Benefit Unit equals 27,000 gallons of water per month. (Each Additional Benefit Unit Cost \$4,500.00)

The engineer and CKRWP advisory committee review applications and determine whether the application is approved or denied. If the rural water engineering application is approved, it is valid for six (6) months from date of committee approval. An approval letter will be sent, with appropriate paperwork and the required fees needed to initiate water service. An approved application does not guarantee water service. Paperwork and connection fees must be paid in full before installation of water service. After 6 months a new engineering application would have to be submitted, if installation has not occurred or fees have not been paid.
